WHILE THE SPRAY PAINT HAS BEEN CLEANED UP...RICHARD FARMER SAYS THE WORDS WERE A DIRECT ATTACK AT HIM AND HIS ROOMMATES...

< 'my roommate is Jewish so that's obviously offensive to him and me being African American the n word is obviously offensive to me, it just wasn't called for at all.">

EVEN THOUGH THE INCIDENT HAPPENED OFF CAMPUS-- THE PRESIDENT OF WESTERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY RELEASED A STATEMENT MONDAY SAYING..
